

TURNER, Ken

Funeral services for Ken Turner will be held Saturday in Cincinnati, Ohio. Turner died on Sept. 28 at the age of 48.

Turner played basketball at Southwestern State University in Weatherford, Oklahoma, and became an assistant coach there after graduating in 1972. He also had been an assistant at the University of Cincinnati, Oklahoma Christian, Oklahoma State, Mississippi and South Alabama. He was working as the Ohio State assistant men's basketball coach when he had a heart attack while jogging a week ago near his home in suburban Westerville. He had been in critical condition since he was admitted at Grant Medical Center on Sept. 21.

Turner is survived by his wife: Margaret; and children: Kenneth II and Kanndra. He is the nephew of Mrs. Ruth Butler and Mr. James Bray of Hugo.
