Notes for SAMUEL MCCOMBS:

One of the hundred State Dragoons selected by the Government of the State of Tennessee to go east and prepare for the emigration of the Indians. After serving in this department, he remained in the employment of the Government at Fort Gibson until 1850.

Child of SAMUEL MCCOMBS and SUSAN STINSON is:

3. i. REV. WILLIAM³ MCCOMBS, b. 22 Jul 1844, 7 miles east of Ft Gibson, Oklahoma.

Generation No. 3

3. REV. WILLIAM³ MCCOMBS (*SAMUEL², ZACHARIAS¹*) was born 22 Jul 1844 in 7 miles east of Ft Gibson, Oklahoma. He married SALLY JACOB 17 Mar 1864 in Red River, daughter of TACOSAR HARGO.

Notes for REV. WILLIAM MCCOMBS:

During Civil War served in the First Creek Regiment, under Col. D. N. McIntosh. The General was frequently heard to say that if all his men were like McCombs, he would fear neither strength or numbers.

1868 he was licensed and ordained as minister of the Baptist Church.

1871 Elected to the House of Warriors. Served 4 years.

1875 Superintendent of Public Instruction. Served 6 years.

1874 Member of the Masonic Order - Eufaula Lodge, No.1
